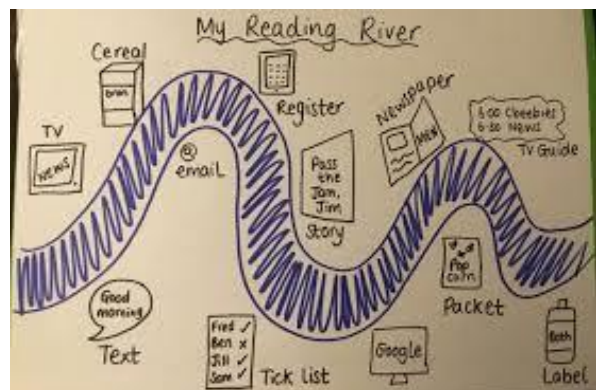
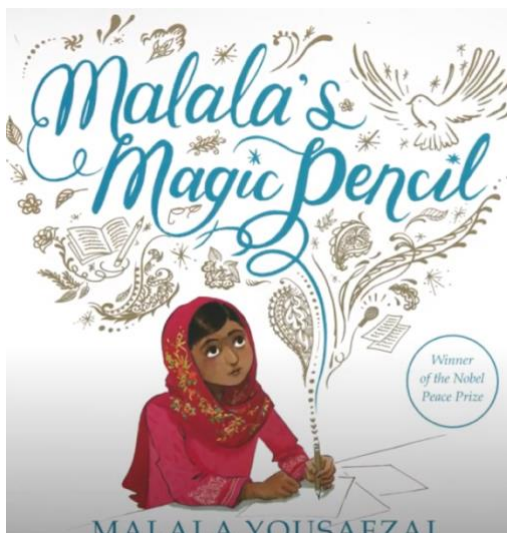
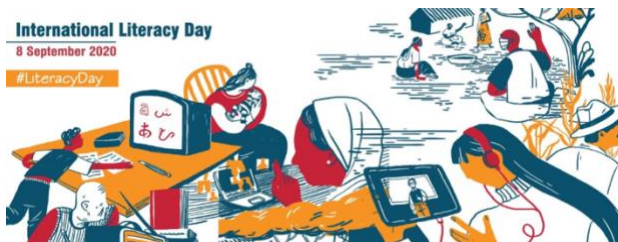


# Promoting Literacy at Hensingham School
