A huge congratulations to all the 111 children who got 100% attendance this week! All reward points have been added. Please keep up the good work and you could win some of our attendance prizes!!

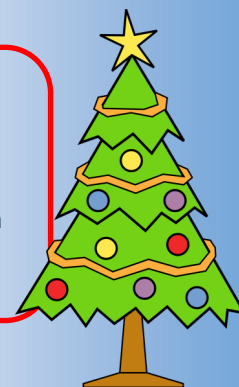

Attendance

At Hensingham Primary School excellent attendance and punctuality is our aim for every child. Full attendance maximises learning opportunities and parents/carers have a critical role in promoting good attitudes in attendance. We ask for support from parents/carers to ensure that their children are present at every opportunity, arrive on time and to avoid allowing children to stay at home unnecessarily, or taking them out of school without authorisation.

Evidence shows that pupils who attend school regularly make better progress both academically and socially. Please do not book holidays in term time.

What to do if your child has an appointment:

We ask that you make routine medical and other appointments out of school time, where possible. If this is not possible, we require notification in advance. **Please provide an appointment letter/card to confirm the appointment.**

In most cases, your child should attend School before the appointment and return to School afterwards wherever possible.
