





Retracking Intervention

This intervention gives materials which can be used with learners at risk of exclusion and for those whose behaviour is extreme. Written by the Deputy Principal Educational Psychologist, Devon LEA, this publication guides students through a process of self-assessment in order to promote their effectiveness at school. Aimed at Secondary and top Primary level students, the process involves Awareness Raising of factors that may have contributed to the current situation, understanding of emotions and behaviour in a variety of settings, and Skills Training to help overcome the areas of difficulty which have been identified.
